<p><b>Assistant Coach*</b></p> <p><b>Role and Responsibilities</b></p> <p>Assistant Coaches will work 5-10 hours weekly in the evenings/mornings; specifically working the 9-12 age group and 8 &amp; Under practices. They will assist in the implementation of season plans, workout plans, developing meet entries, coaching coverage of any or all scheduled swim meets, and limited and various other Eagles at Exeter Swim Team duties as assigned on a per need basis.</p> <p>Furthermore, Assistant Coaches must participate in all scheduled staff meetings in a professional manner, and be prepared to provide insight and feedback as requested. Safety is a priority, both for coaching staff and swimmers; model safe behavior, and supervise swimmers to ensure safe behavior at all times.</p> <p><b>Qualifications and Education Requirements</b></p> <p>In addition to being able to attend most practices and meets (Wednesday evenings &amp; Saturday mornings) Assistant Coaches must be high school graduates with a minimum of one year swim lesson experience with a demonstrated ability to develop young athletes; coaching experience preferred. They must have also been a member of the Eagles at Exeter Swim Team for one season prior to the upcoming season. Current CPR/AED and First Aide status required; a current Pool Operator's License and WSI certification is preferred but not required.</p> <p><b>Preferred Skills</b></p> <p>Assistant Coaches must possess a strong work ethic, and positive attitude demonstrated through previous experience. The candidate must also demonstrate effective, respectful communication skills with swimmers, parents, and coaching staff.</p> <p><i>* In the event that the Exeter at Eagles Swim Team has three or more qualified applicants for the Assistant Coach position, the Eagles at Exeter Board will develop an additional position on the coaching staff. This position will be titled "Assistant Head Coach" and that person's role and responsibilities will change to reflect 12-24 hours devoted to the Eagles at Exeter Swim Team weekly and this applicant will be required to hold a current Pool Operator's License and WSI (Water Safety Instructor) certification. This member of the coaching staff would help the Head Coach oversee the Assistant Coaches and Junior Coaches and would be expected to help at all three Eagles practices unless the Head Coach deems otherwise.</i></p>
